<b>Prosecco Spumante “Vispo Allegro” NV</b> VENETO, ITALY	7.00	30.95
Fruity, lively and clean with surprising depth of flavour. Hints of greengage and lemon.		
<b>Crémant Brut “Carte Azure”, Salasar NV</b> LIMOUX, FRANCE	8.50	36.95
Lovely light and refreshing aperitif style wine from Limoux, widely thought to be birthplace of Sparkling wine. Closer in style to Champagne than Prosecco.		
<b>Taittinger Brut Réserve NV</b> CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE		75.95
The Brut Réserve NV is Taittinger's signature cuvée. Bright, delicate and fresh with subtle notes of bread and a fine lingering mousse. A great NV Champagne.		
<b>Taittinger Prestige Rosé NV</b> CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE		85.95
Prestige Rose displays charm and subtle harmony of flavours. Its aromas are fresh with wild strawberries and a hint of spice. On the palate this lively, fruity, fresh and elegant wine is balanced and smooth with good length.		
<b>Taittinger Brut Vintage 2015</b> CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE		95.95
Taittinger produce a vintage champagne only when the harvest has been of exceptional quality. Flint and yeasty bread on the nose, the palate is rich and smooth releasing flavours of sugared pink grapefruit. The exceptional intensity of the finish is long, generous and complex.

<b>Chardonnay “Sea Change” 2021</b> SALENTO, ITALY			28.95
Every bottle of Sea Change wine sold helps fund conservation projects around the globe. Easy-drinking and packed with citrus and tropical fruit flavours. Crisp and fresh.			
<b>Rioja Blanco “Don Placero” 2021</b> RIOJA, SPAIN	7.70	10.85	30.95
An unoaked, fruity and aromatic wine packed with citrus, fresh peach and juicy apple flavours.			
<b>Organic Viognier “GEN” Yalumba 2021</b> SOUTH AUSTRALIA	9.10	12.85	36.95
This wine is certified by the Australian Certified Organic standards. It's made without the use of chemical fertilisers and pesticides in the vineyard. With very few additions, the wine goes through wild fermentation, using only the natural yeasts present in the vineyard and on grape skins. The palate is rich and textured, full of exotic aromas and complex fruit flavours.			
<b>Albarino “Pazo das Bruxas”, Torres 2021</b> RIÁS BAIXAS, SPAIN	10.30	14.50	41.95
Delicate and fragrant, with lime blossom and lemon marmalade notes. Silky and savory on the palate, elegantly structured.			
<b>Sancerre “Terres Blanches”, Domaine Roblin 2021</b> LOIRE, FRANCE	13.30	18.85	54.95
Classically loire valley in style. Crisp, concentrated and textured green fruits with expressive aromas of white currants and nettles.			

## Light and refreshing white wines

<b>Côtes de Gascogne “Le Serin” 2021</b> CÔTES DE GASCOGNE, FRANCE	6.35	8.85	24.95
A delicious blend of Colombard, Sauvignon Blanc and Ugni Blanc. Steely and zesty with grapefruit freshness and subtle hints of spiced pear.			
<b>Grüner Veltliner “Little Cricket” 2021</b> PANNON, HUNGARY			25.95
This Hungarian take on an Austrian classic is a little gem. Dry, clean and crisp with citrus notes, yellow plum, light green apple and a hint of white pepper.			
<b>Sauvignon Blanc “Riviera” 2022</b> SOUTHERN FRANCE	6.80	9.50	26.95
An easy drinking fruity and clean Sauvignon Blanc with notes of white flowers and tropical fruits.			
<b>Pinot Grigio “Conviviale” 2022</b> VENEZIA, ITALY	7.00	9.85	27.95
Ripe orchard fruits on the nose with hints of honey and peach. Lightly spicy with good weight and texture, balanced by fresh acidity.			

## Fruity, herbaceous and aromatic white wines

<b>Vermentino “Zagare” 2021</b> SICILY, ITALY	7.25	10.15	28.95
Ripe stone fruit aromas with zesty lemon and floral notes. The palate has bright citrus peel and peach characters, an appealing texture and minerality, fresh acidity and a gently savoury finish.			
<b>Viognier “Caoba” 2021</b> MENDOZA, ARGENTINA	7.95	11.15	31.95
Floral and aromatic, fresh and unctuous. Delicate aromas of white flowers with stone fruits on the palate.			
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Allan Scott Estate 2022</b> MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND	9.35	13.15	37.95
Allan Scott is a true pioneer of the Marlborough region. This wine is punchy and vibrant with excellent varietal purity, finishing long and refreshing with flavours of apple, nectarine and lime peel.			
<b>Riesling, Pewsey Vale 2020</b> EDEN VALLEY, AUSTRALIA			45.95
Pale straw with green hues. Intense aromas of fine dried herbs, white flowers, lemon and lime. A long and rich palate, reminiscent of grapefruit, lime and fresh rosemary.

Rich and fresh with flavours of passion fruit, white flowers and honeysuckle. Superb lengthy finish, revealing notes of vanilla and apricot.			
<b>Chardonnay “Helmsman” 2020</b> CENTRAL RANGES, AUSTRALIA	7.70	10.85	30.95
A fresh and vibrant offering from Robert Oatley. Pineapple, stone fruit, fig and subtle citrus flavours, balanced by toasty oak.			
<b>Gavi di Gavi “Nuovo Quadro”, La Battistina 2021</b> PIEMONTE, ITALY	7.95	11.15	31.95
An enticing nose of white peach and pear with hints of fresh lime and gooseberry. Fresh and zesty citrus notes and ripe peachy characters are balanced by crisp acidity and mineral notes leading to a textured complex finish.			
<b>Chablis, Domaine de la Motte 2021</b> BURGUNDY, FRANCE	9.60	13.50	38.95
A classic Chablis from vines grown on the famous Kimmeridgian clay with nervy, mineral fruit. A modest use of oak adds richness and balance.

Cherry and redcurrants on the nose with just a hint of spring flowers. The palate is rich, smooth and balanced. Fruity with great length.

<b>Rosé, Domaine Valfont 2021</b> CÔTEAUX D'AIX-EN-PROVENCE, FRANCE	8.65	12.15	34.95
Attractively fruity, this is a crisp and light wine. With a touch of caramel under the red fruits, it is lively, with balanced acidity.

Dark cherry colour. Fine fruity aromas with notes of balsamic. Elegant and fruity palate with a prolonged finish.			
<b>Pinot Noir ‘L’Artisan’ 2021</b> PAYS D’OC, FRANCE 			35.95
Light red garnet red with aromas of red fruits, morello cherries and raspberries. This wine is medium-bodied, perfectly balanced and generous with supple tannins			
<b>Shiraz, Wild Ferment, Yalumba 2021</b> BAROSSA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA 	9.60	13.50	38.95
A generous nose of rhubarb, berry cheesecake, jelly and jam, warm nutmeg and cinnamon followed by violet, raisin and cherry. The palate shows smokiness, boysenberry and sweet spice leading onto plush chewy tannins.			
<b>Valpolicella Classico “Lucchine”, Tedeschi 2021</b> VENETO, ITALY 	10.50	14.85	42.95
The Tedeschi vineyards are set in the foot of the Pedemonte hills. This wine is fresh and lively with plump red fruits and a juicy lingering finish.			
<b>Barolo Bussia, Dardi le Rose, Poderi Colla 2018</b> PIEMONTE, ITALY 			80.95
Warm, open, sensuous nose with aromas of fresh red and dried fruits, leather, brown spices and delicate floral notes. The palate is generous, supple and approachable, combining freshness and youth with complexity, spice and fine-grained tannins.

<b>Gamay/Pinot Noir “Phalangère”, Jean Loron 2020</b> COTEAUX BOURGUIGNONS, FRANCE 	8.65	12.15	34.95
A vibrant blend from this relatively new Burgundian appellation. It has aromas of red cherries and raspberries with good generosity of bold sweet fruit and a refreshing finish.			
<b>Pinot Noir, Oliver Zeter 2021</b> PFALZ, GERMANY 	11.00	15.50	44.95
The Pinot Noir displays attractive red fruits, cream and spice on the nose with a fine, diverse and elegant cherry favour, balanced and tasty finish			
<b>Nuits-St-George, Domaine Bertrand Ambroise 2017</b> BURGUNDY, FRANCE 			84.95
From numerous plots in the southern half of Nuits Saint Georges. Aged in 50% new oak barrels, this is dense and concentrated with wonderful, red cherry and blackberry fruit and a touch of spice and oak.

Soft and full-bodied with rich, ripe flavours of plum, blackcurrant and berry. Long and elegant with a hint of oak.			
<b>“Terra Boa” Old Wines, Bacalhoa 2020/21</b> BEIRAS, PORTUGAL 	7.25	10.15	28.95
Aromas of ripe bramble fruit, plum and a touch of spice. Generous on the palate with fresh red cherry and blackberry leaf characters.			
<b>Malbec “Caoba” Estate 2020/21</b> MENDOZA, ARGENTINA	8.65	12.15	34.95
Medium bodied with good concentration and length. Soft, elegant and persistent, with a pinch of fruit and spice flavours.			
<b>Bobal “Las Aldeas” 2020</b> UTIEL-REQUENA, SPAIN 			42.95
Intense ruby in colour. Powerful and complex with forest fruit aromas together with a floral background. Full bodied, velvety with smooth tannins and a long finish.

A fabulous blend from the southern Rhone. Expressive black fruits wrapped in silky tannins with a touch of oak. Juicy, spicy and perfect with red meat.			
<b>Château Grande Clotte, Lussac-Saint-Émilion 2015</b> BORDEAUX, FRANCE	9.60	13.50	38.95
Expressive and open on the nose with notes of ripe berry fruit mixed with vanilla spice. Lovely definition of bramble fruit in the mouth, balanced and silky with a nice freshness and good length.			
<b>Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Azienda Agricola Lunadoro 2018</b> TUSCANY, ITALY 			46.95
Complex nose with mature fruits and pepper aromas, as well as plum jam and floral notes of violet, chocolate and cigar. Balanced with sweet tannins, good acidity and a long finish.

Lovely delicate salmon pink. Crisp firm fruity nose. Soft round juicy berry fruit on the palate matched by firm and elegant acidity. A wine for all occasions and right up in the league of top Provençal Rosés				
<b>Bacchus, Flint Vineyards 2021</b> NORFOLK, ENGLAND 	9.60	13.50		38.95
Fermented and aged in neutral oak for 11 months. This is powerful, fresh, exotic and lively. There’s some sweetness to the fruit, which is dominated by elderflower with some green apple and citrus.				
<b>Silex Blanc, Flint Vineyard 2021</b> NORFOLK, ENGLAND 				42.95
A complex wine, with floral notes overlaying fresh spice and toasted almond. A zippy palate with good structure.				
<b>Pinot Noir Précoce, Flint Vineyards 2021</b> NORFOLK, ENGLAND				46.95
This wine shows a wonderful complexity of fruit with sour cherry and cranberry shining through. The palate is soft yet structured, akin to a Beaujolais Cru from Fleurie.				



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
